2023/02 Declaration of Members Interests
J Morrison-Bell declared an interest in planning matters.

2023/03 Minutes of the previous meeting held 16th November 2022
It was resolved that the minutes of the previous meeting held 16th November 2022 be accepted as a true record.

2023/10/01 Drainage issues between Lanehead and High Green

Part of the road had been marked for works, and there were still blocked drains. Clerk to report blocked drain outside of Lanehead Village Hall to County Council.

2023/10/02 Review of parish road signage

County Council had confirmed receipt of the report compiled relating to current parish road signage. The requests could be considered for the 2023-2024 budget and in the meantime the County Council maintenance team would see if they could tidy the signage.

2023/10/03 Infringement of road at Bridge End

Photographic evidence was to be forwarded to the County Council regarding infringement of the road at Bridge End, however J Morrison-Bell to firstly carry out a site visit.

2023/11 To receive update on governance review, to remove the division of two wards

No further information had been received regarding the governance review.

2023/12 To consider King Charles Coronation

Parishioner comment had been received requesting no fireworks be organised due to the distress suffered to animals during the Platinum Celebrations. S Coxon, a member of the Village Hall Committee, to discuss with the Committee possible celebrations that could be held in the Hall. A sum of £500 was included in the Parish Council 2023-2024 budget towards an event(s).


2023/13 Urgent Business/Items for next agenda
