## Current applications

The Northumberland National Park Authority (NNPA) is consulting on one application for the designation of a neighbourhood area. The application shows the area in which **Tarset and Greystead Parish Council** intend to use the neighbourhood planning powers arising from the Localism Act 2011 and the supporting neighbourhood planning regulations. Representations should consider whether the neighbourhood area being proposed is appropriate to be designated.

Tarset and Greystead Parish straddles the Northumberland National Park boundary and as a consequence has two Local Planning Authorities. NNPA's decision will only relate to the part of the part of the proposed neighbourhood area which is in the National Park. The remaining part of the parish lies within Northumberland County Council (NCC) and the decision as to whether to designate that part of the Parish will be considered by that authority.
