DESCRIPTION

The fragmentary remains of a sub-rectangular enclosure consisting of a low, spread bank, from 3.5m to 4.0m wide, on the NW, SW and SE sides - the other side having been destroyed by ploughing. Internally there are two slightly depressed areas adjacent to the SE side, with an even slighter depression opening on to the northerly of these. The entrance is no longer apparent. The remains are certainly those of a Romano British Homestead or small Settlement.
