#### **DESCRIPTION**

Tarset was a demesne manor in the Liberty of Tynedale, owing suit to the court of Wark. In 1326 most of the demesne was uncultivated for lack of tenants. No indication of the size or composition of the medieval settlement has been found. The survey of decays in 1584 recorded all 19 tenants of Tarset were slain by Scots. The hearth Tax of 1666 lists 13 houses there. It is not known whether the tenements formed a nucleated settlement. Tarset presently comprises a Farmstead [Tarset Hall] and the Castle Remains. No other earthworks seen. [HVA]
