Former Methodist Church, built 1903. Three bays, eaves to the road, Snecked stone, Welsh slate gabled roof with square-cut gable copings, single stack chimney to the right. Three pointed arch windows on the road side, four modern roof lights above. Extends at the back? Former vestry. C20th gabled porch to right. Contemporary cast-iron railings in front with elaborate spearhead finials. Square ashlar end piers with pyramidical caps Converted to a house in 1980.
