## DESCRIPTION

The present main hall was rebuilt after a fire and cost approximately £250. It was re-opened in April 1931. Single storey, 6 bays, with a lean-to kitchen extension at the back. The walls are clad in horizontal timber boards on a brick base, the roof is red corrugated iron. The front, facing the road, has 2-leaf doors under small pedimented hoods in bays 1 & 6 with four 8-pane casement windows in bays 2-5. Extended at the S. end in 2007 to provide a meeting room and improved kitchen. A parish garden was opened in 2009.
