
DESCRIPTION

Border Counties Railway Bridge No. 79 [tbc] a **3-span** masonry skew bridge carrying the BCR over the Tarset Burn. Built to carry a double line, only a single track was ever laid. When inspected for the Board of Trade prior to opening this section of the line in 1861, the Inspector commented that he was not entirely happy with the masonry and that the bridge 'should be watched'. His caution appears to have been justified as the eastern span has been reinforced at some time with concrete ribs. According to Messrs Moore [personal communication] the piers in the burn were showing signs of scour and were underpinned by piles at a cost of c£50,000 not long before the line closed. Scour has continued and some of these piles are now visible.
