DESCRIPTION

Detached house and attached outbuildings, probably late C18th; house remodelled and extended in later C19th.C18th parts rubble with cut quoins and dressings,. C19th parts snecked stone with ashlar dressings. Welsh slate roofs.

The present plan is a result of the original farmhouse being doubled in width and having a rear wing added in the late C19th (c. 1860-70?) Present front (facing south west) has a central half-glazed door flanked by full height canted bays with pyramidal roofs; plate glass sash windows. Coped gables with stepped and corniced end stacks to both spans. Set back to the right is a range of C19th outhouses linking to an older outbuilding, which has roof trusses re-using earlier cruck blades. [Grundy 1987]
