DESCRIPTION


The 1st Edition 6 inch map shows a rectangular building with a small [?Garden] enclosure at the NW end. Some of the stone walls survive in present field boundaries, but the overall plan of the original structures appears to have been lost. Old and less regular boundaries of fields surrounding the site appear on the 1862 O.S. map and parts of these are visible on 1974 Air photos.
