DESCRIPTION

Described in the Tasset & Greenhaugh HVA as "outbarn and fields" the Grid Reference quoted corresponds to a site shown on the first Edition 6 inch O.S. Map, NBL sheet 60, surveyed, 1862 as "Pasture House". This map shows a small rectangular building, possibly roofed. It may perhaps have been re-named by later editions. Linked to High Shield [A0051] by a hollow way [A0053].
