DESCRIPTION

Disused sandstone quarries. A quarry to the SW of the former Lanehead crossroads is visible but overgrown. A separate quarry to the S. of the crossroads has been infilled and now underlies part of the garden of The Old Chapel (A0035) where a slight 'step' in the garden may indicate the position of the top of the quarry face.

These quarries may have been the source of the stone for Tarset Castle (A0004)
