
DESCRIPTION

One end 'bastle' wall without doorway survives, with the outline of a building with narrower walls to the west. This seems likely to be the remnant of the largest of the three buildings shown on the 1862 map. This had a small, possibly garden, enclosure, and was probably the farmhouse. A more detailed survey is needed.
