EVIDENCE

Shown and named as 'CAMP' on 1st Edition of OS '6 inch' Map Northumberland Old series Sheet 59 Surveyed in 1862. Clearly visible on air photographs.

DESCRIPTION

A formerly wooded site trapezoidal in plan, but with earth banks on the East and South sides. These are probably the remains of a Romano-British settlement, roughly square in plan damaged by the construction of the Border Counties Railway c 1860 which was driven through it. More details are given in the Pastscape record but there appears to have been some disagreement about the scope of the earthworks. It is recorded that an iron axe with an iron handle was found when the west side was removed. [Pastscape]
