DESCRIPTION

A long building, the original front facing south, the house to the left and a farm building to the right. The latter was partly converted to provide accommodation for a children's riding centre. The original front door, which has been replaced by a window, gave access to a cross-passage which separated the house from the farm building. There are at least 7 bays on the frontage with windows of different sizes and patterns. To the rear the former farmyard and the present front door. To its left an external stone stairway to the first floor of the farm building. A large window has been inserted at first floor level in the west gable of the house. On the north side of the yard a range of single storey buildings (no details) and there are various other farm buildings attached.
