DESCRIPTION

The OS plan (above) show s the outline of a small building of two roughly equal rectangular sections, apparently roofed, within a small enclosure. A well and a tree are shown about 10-15 m ENE of the building. The site is adjacent to the Thorneyburn Head Dyke (A0202) and might have been occupied by a shepherd tending flocks on the unenclosed Thorneyburn Common. There may be traces of masonry on the ground.
