### **EVIDENCE**

Named on 1<sup>st</sup> Edition of OS '6 inch' Map Northumberland Old Series Sheet 59 Surveyed 1862, and modern O.S. maps.

### DESCRIPTION

The road, now a forest track, was constructed as part of the works associated with the Parliamentary Enclosure of Thorneyburn Common, 1803-1804 to c1820. The first edition of the O.S. six-inch map indicates an actual gate on the road, but the term 'gate' often refers to a road, cf. modern Norwegian. 'Hospital' refers to the Commissioners of the Greenwich Hospital for Seamen, who were the Lords of the Manor, following the confiscation of the Derwentwater Estates.
