DESCRIPTION

A series of substantial turf-covered stony banks defines a group of yards and fields associated with the Black Middens bastle group (A0296 and A0301) and the later, eighteenth-century farm (A0297). The banks are up to 1.2m high and 5.2m thick. Within some of the fields ridge and furrow cultivation survives; the ridges of which are little more than 0.1m high are 4.2m to 10.0m wide.
