Building extant.

DESCRIPTION

Early C19th. A very small two-storey mill. Coursed stone with tooled-and-margined ashlar dressings. Central boarded door with flanking 9-pane fixed windows. The upstairs windows are blocked. Gabled Welsh slate roof with one small chimney. The fine masonry on the right was formerly the wheelhouse. [Grundy 1987]
