Described by Grundy as Dally Castle Farmhouse. Late C18th. Two storeys and now four bays. The third bay is a later insertion. The right part of the house was formerly the stable and granary. Converted in the 1940s. Roughly-coursed rubble with dressings. Renewed sash windows all in original alternating block surround. Gabled Welsh slate roof with banded chimneys. Lower rear wing mid C19th. [Grundy 1987].
