Originally a pair of semi-detached three-bay cottages, each with a central front door, White render and slate roofs. Grundy (1987) reports 12-pane sashes and a continuous outshot to the rear.

Built for workers at Carrith Pit. Used as a refugee hostel in the second world war. Converted in the late 1980s into a single building and leased to Gateshead Council as a residential hostel/adventure centre for young people. Now a private house.
