DESCRIPTION

Large long mound adjacent to a sheepfold, south of the house at Birks, which has the appearance of a natural feature. A line of loose stones and rocks lying along the top of the mound, lie in such a fashion as to appear to be the foundations of a former extension of the NE wall of the sheepfold. There are no traces of a ditch or encircling retaining wall of stone. The site is upon open moorland with a northern slope. Later interpreted as a natural rock outcrop measuring 24.0m in length NW-SE, 14.0m in width, and with a max height of 3.4m; adjacent outcrops to the north and south also have this orientation.
