A ford is shown here on the 1st Edition of OS '6 inch' Map Northumberland Old Series Sheet 59 Surveyed 1862. It is not known when the present bridge was built. No information on when or why the weir was built, but it may have been to prevent scour of the foundations of this bridge or the railway bridge (A0045) upstream.
