## DESCRIPTION

An area of disturbed ground which extends over three fields on the left (east bank) of the Tasset Burn. The landform consists of a series of roughly parallel small scarps separating relatively level areas. These could be the result of landslipping or of shallow workings for coal or the site might have been used as a borrow pit for earthworks on the nearby Border Counties Railway.
