DESCRIPTION

Former school room and schoolmaster's house converted into a single dwelling. The school opened in February 1865 and closed in 1963.

1 ½ storey building, eaves and back to the road. Stone, the house front of high quality, gabled slate roof with square-cut copings and two stacks, one between the house and school and one on the right gable. From the front: to the left the schoolroom (full height) 3 bays, 1&2 with tall 15 pane windows, a projecting stone porch with gabled slate roof and close verges, the house three bays, central front door, ground floor left window 12-pane sash, right window a pair of eight pane sashes divided by a stone mullion. First floor two stone dormers with 12-pane sashes. All house (and school ?) windows may be replacements. [from photographs]
