### **DESCRIPTION**

Shown on the 1<sup>st</sup> Edition of OS '6 inch' Map Northumberland Old Series Sheet 59 Surveyed 1862 as two separate quarry faces. Successive editions of O.S. maps show that these were extended to form an elongated quarry. Development into the hillside would have been restricted by a rapid increase in overburden. The quarry is now overgrown with no limestone exposed.
