DESCRIPTION

An irregular-shaped enclosure bounded by a bank of large stones, situated at approx 510 feet above OD upon a SE facing slope. The ground falls away at approx 1:6 on the east and south sides to the course of the Low Carriteth Burn, and rises gradually to the west. Period of construction or purpose could not be identified. The work does not closely parallel the usual Romano-British type of enclosure found locally, but there are similarities in size, form and construction (rubble walling). In poor condition. Internally there are slight traces of occasional low, turf covered stone banks, too indefinite to identify with any certainty. [after Pastscape]
