DESCRIPTION

Said to be c1810, C20th extensions. Two storey, three bays, symmetrical. Rubble with tooled and margined quoins and dressings; flanked by renewed 16 pane sash windows, with renewed 12 pane sashes to first floor. Coped gables, welsh slate roof, stepped end stacks. C20th extensions to right and at rear. [Grundy 1987].
