DESCRIPTION

Extensive earthwork consisting of a bank and ditch, the latter in one area at the north end cut into rock. The ditch is particularly deep at the southern end where it lies south of the adjacent road. The feature appears to have enclosed an area which is roughly D-shaped in plan, the straight length formed by the Lancy's Cleugh, and was probably a head dyke, perhaps associated with the former farmstead, A0055.
