DESCRIPTION

<p>Built 1830-1840. Two storey house, carriage house and granary, all under one roof; single-storey byres and stables attached to left. House 3 bays, slightly later stone porch. Dressed stone, C20th brick chimneys. Welsh slate roof. Doors and windows are all satisfactory. Late C20th renewals. Buildings Coursed stone. Carriage house to left. Segmental arch with boarded doors. The former granary is now part of the house. Its pitching door has now been replaced by a window. To right two byres and one stable with boarded doors. The stable has a hay loft. Attractive garden wall. Dry stone wall, broken in centre by a gate with simple arched gate posts. Late C19th hay shed to rear. [Grundy 1987]</p>
