DESCRIPTION

The mouth of the adit is close to the Hollinhead Burn. It appears to be blocked a short distance inside. It has been reported that this was a trial for lead (cf A0486) but the BGS map (Ref. 1.) shows the outcrop of the Highgreen (Fourlaws) Coal at this point and it seems more likely that it was driven for coal.
