EVIDENCE

Extant, Shown on 1st Edition of OS '6 inch' Map Northumberland Old Series Sheet 60 Surveyed 1862.

DESCRIPTION

A lime kiln with a single pot, now mostly infilled, with two triangular arches in a poor state of repair, the right hand arch in particular damaged by tree roots and collapsing. Sited to receive stone directly from the adjacent limestone quarries (A0531), coal being obtained from the numerous pits in the vicinity. The quarries do not appear to have been extended much since the 1862 survey.
