EVIDENCE

Extant. Shown on 1st Edition of OS '6 inch' Map Northumberland Old Series Sheet 60
Surveyed 1862 but rebuilt since then.

DESCRIPTION

Described by Grundy as late C19, well preserved 1 ½ storey 3-bay cottage with a large gabled porch and 12-pane sashes on the ground floor [since replaced]. Snecked stone with rock-faced surrounds Gabled Welsh slate roof with overhanging eaves and large end stacks.

Kennels for Highgreen Manor to the rear, single storey 4-bay kennels. Dressed stone with rock-faced dressings. Gabled Welsh slate roof with moulded kneelers. Exercise yards in front with high looped iron railings. Small square chimney to the left for the meat boiler.
