A pair of semi-detached, 2-storey houses extremely beautifully situated. Each is two bays with a broad gable over the outer bay and a small gable over the inner bay. They have sash windows with small-paned upper sashes and plate-glass lower sashes. On each return wall there is a gabled porch and a small asymmetrical-set gabled dormer. [Grundy 1987]
