#### **EVIDENCE**

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Stable block built around 1885 for Mr. Morrison Bell, incorporating the walls of mid-19<sup>th</sup> Century farm buildings. Rock-faced stone with Welsh slate roofs. L-plan group. To right the gable ends of two stable blocks linked by lean-to loggia with two segmental arches. The block to left has small 3-light window on ground floor, round-arched dovecote entry above. The block to right has boarded stable door within the loggia and, above, a 3-light window with blocked centre light which is carved with a bell. Gabled roofs with hollow-chamfered coping. Projecting to left a single-storey, 3-bay cart shed. Two segmental arches to right with boarded double doors. Boarded double doors in left bay. Gabled roof with flat coping and square corniced end stack.

#### **NOTES**

A complex site consisting of the manor house developed from farmhouse(s) c 1890s, various houses (Nos. 1-7 Highgreen) and extensive outbuildings. See Grundy/HER for more details. Only the main site (A0500) and Nos. 1&2 Highgreen (A0542) are listed in the Gazetteer and plotted in the TAG Atlas. These sites deserve a more comprehensive survey.
