DESCRIPTION

According to Grundy: A terrace of cottages, formerly 4 now redivided into 3. Boarded doors and 4-pane sashes. From photographs it appears that No. 1 is the combined dwelling. Two storeys, originally probably 2-bays each, squared rubble with alternating block surrounds to doors and windows. Slate roof with square-cut copings on the gables. A gabled stone porch has been added to No. 1.
