DESCRIPTION

North end house of the terrace on the west side of the road. According to Grundy the Blacksmith's Shop "has been altered. It formerly had a lintel dated 1719 and indeed the lower part of the walls look that date."

According to the Tarset Millennium Book, the building was originally single storey and a second storey was added in 1719. The smithy was closed in 1955. Used a store until 1980 when it became a garage. Converted into a house in 1995. The dated lintel was moved to Burnmouth when the garage was being refurbished. Coursed rubble with replaced 4-pane sash windows, the end (right) gable with a square-cut coping and a short stack.
